The Church: In our last prayer letter we asked you to pray for Sofia, a Greek lady who had been coming to church for the last month or so. We are happy to say she got saved and has not missed church since. All the Greeks who have been saved recently strangely enough have been very faithful in coming to church. Please continue to pray for their spiritual growth.

Our Christian school has begun again with a new headmaster George Antonios, a brilliant young Lebanese man with countless talents who is sacrificing for our children. The AWANA program is back in full swing with 35 or more young kids. The preachers' course will begin shortly and the other ministries, radio, tract distribution, etc. are continuing.

We have been very busy with painting our building and other much needed repairs this summer. Happy to say it is now nearly finished. The work took months of Saturdays plus a lot of money and men to accomplish. We continue with all our outreaches in the community we are in. We have added another place to pass out our tracts and preach each week.

Personally: I know it has been a while since our last letter for the following reasons. Our last three months have again been full of tragedies and triumphs in our family. As most all of you know our precious granddaughter Danielle was involved in an ATV accident that nearly took her life.

The prayer lines went out to all of our supporters, friends and loved ones through every available means asking our Lord to spare Danielle's life. We are so thankful to our Lord Jesus for answering all our prayers in her behalf. Without being too graphic with details, she had flipped off the ATV backwards and her hair was caught somehow in the axle literally scalping her. She was dragged a long way also on the pavement taking huge chunks of flesh out of her feet and legs.

Judi and I ran to her side as fast as we could. Our hearts were broken for her and the severe pain that she endured. For several weeks we saw our 16 year old granddaughter crying in pain as the doctors and nurses were doing all that was humanly possible to help. This was like a nightmare for us.

It was through your prayers for her to our Great Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ she got through this. I am so thankful for the great care of the doctors and nurses who worked constantly to save her. Danielle is truly a miracle of the Lord in how she has recovered. After over two months and the painful skin grafts she is almost back to normal. She still has more skin grafts and hair transplants to endure and needs your continued prayers.

We have learned many things from this but the main two are our Lords' mercy to us in allowing Danielle to live, and the Lord's people who answered the call to prayer for us all each day. Heaven became more real than ever before, especially the part about no more pain, or sorrow, or crying. We had many opportunities to witness to a lot of young people who need the Lord thru this tragedy. Pray the word sown will bring forth some fruit in their lives.

The next trial came with our son Michael Todd and his wife Traci who was pregnant with our grandson. She had pre-eclampsia, a condition that can be very serious to both mother and child. She was rushed to the hospital and our grandson Jason was taken 6 weeks early into this world. We again sought the prayers of Gods' people for them. And again the tragic situation was handled by our Great Physician and turned it into triumph with the great care of attending doctors and nurses. After 10 days in the NICU baby Jason Leonidas Theros is at home with both Mother and child doing well. Thanks so much for everyone's prayers for our family. Thanks so much for the many years of your faithful prayer and financial support to meet our needs. Till later, we are....
